The **SCHOOL** strives to:

- Provide a caring, happy safe environment where teachers and children share a mutual respect for each other;
- Ensure that each child is given the opportunity to achieve his/her full potential;
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of individual children and a work ethic with a sense of purpose;
- Be open and welcoming;
- Provide opportunities for parents to become involved in the life of the school and in particular discuss the progress of their children;
- Deal with any incidents of bullying or inappropriate behaviour firmly and in a manner appropriate to the situation;
- Deal with complaints according to agreed school policy (a copy of which is available from the Headteacher on request);
- Bring everyone to an understanding of God' Love.

PARENTS / GUARDIANS will strive to:

- Ensure that the child attends school regularly and on time (8:55a.m.) properly equipped and wearing school uniform;
- Inform the school if he/she is absent on the first day of absence;
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour;
- Support the child in any aspect of home learning;
- Let the school know of any changes that may affect his/her work or behaviour;
- Attend parents' evening or any other meeting arranged to discuss the child's progress;
- Be supportive of the school's work and acknowledge that decisions are made in the best interests of the pupils;
- Not speak of the school or its staff in derogatory terms on social media;
- Support events organised by the school and Parents' Association.

The **CHILD** will strive to:

- Keep the agreed school rules which at All Saints' are:
 - We are polite and helpful to everyone;
 - We get on with our work and let other get on with theirs;
 - We look after other people's property as we would look after or own;
 - We keep our school clean and tidy;
 - We always move around the school safely and sensibly;
 - Tell an adult if anyone is unhappy or being treated unkindly.
